
I look forward to seeing familiar faces across the bridge table very soon.

BIDDING TIPS FROM NICK

When an opponent bid your best suit

Usually you pass or bid notrumps, or perhaps raise partner's suit. Almost never double. Take this: NORTH EAST SOUTH

NORTH EAST SOU 1♥ 1♠ ?

♦AJT54 ♥6 ♦Q854 ♣T92

Just pass and hope they go down. Your singleton heart suggests the hand is a mis-fit, in which case it's best to defend. If partner had opened $1 \\ +$, then show the fit by raising to $2 \\ +$.

NORTH	EAST	SOUTH
1♥	2♣	?
▲ T76 ♥ K3	♦ Q854	 ♦KT94

Pass again. 2NT here would show 11-12 points, inviting opener to bid game. You don't have enough for that. NORTH EAST SOUTH 3♠ ? ♣KQ53 ♥J6 ♦AQ3 ♣AQT3

Bid 3NT with fingers crossed. You would like more points but that is all they dealt you. Can't pass and double would ask partner to bid a suit, not what you want.
