
The schedule for face to face Bridge is as yet to be determined and we wish Terry every success with her negotiations with Easts Management on the Bridge Club's behalf.

West could bid 4H straight off but the hand is too STRONG for that. You might miss a slam.

Declarer wins the D10 lead in dummy (high from the short side) then takes the diamond ruff BEFORE playing trumps.

Next lead the HJ for a finesse, trapping North's king. After trumps or drawn, lead twice towards dummy's C-QJ. 11 tricks are possible!
