Typical infractions are: - a call out of rotation, a card faced out of rotation, an insufficient bid or a revoke.

What you should not do is to "make your own arrangements", no matter what you might think the correct next step to be. "Rectification" as applied by the director is an attempt to restore equity, to prevent an unfair disadvantage and to restore the players to where they would have been, but for the infraction

# **COMParable calls** (Accent on the FIRST syllable, please!)

Comparable calls are introduced in the 2017 reincarnation of the "Laws of Duplicate Bridge" and usually apply when you have made an insufficient bid or a call out of turn. If condoned, nothing changes, play on as usual. If not condoned, you will still be okay and partner will be allowed to bid, if you replace that call with a *comparable* call. A call is "comparable" if:- (1) it has a <u>similar meaning</u> as the withdrawn call. Or (2) defines a <u>subset</u> of the hands that would make the withdrawn call. Or (3) has the same <u>purpose</u> (like Stayman).

West North East South

(1D) 1H (opened out of turn, dealer being East) 1H – This 1H overcall is NOT a comparable

bid. It is not a subset of 1H openings. You can still bid 1H if you wish, but partner will have to pass once.
